BACKGROUND

• The RTO offers its training and assessment services to North Queensland based schools with a focus on Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander clients. The RTO originally focused on delivering Certificate II in Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander Primary Health Care. The success of the program resulted in the RTO adding Certificate II in Conservation Land Management at the request of several schools as an indigenous ranger pilot program. The RTO has a pool of trainers and assessors who are respected in their vocation and it is evident that they have had a direct input to the training and assessment materials developed and utilised by the RTO. The programs are funded by federal government initiatives with the funds released to individual schools.

- The RTO works closely with several schools to ensure students have access to suitable facilities and equipment which reflect those found in the workplace. Most recently one school opened a state of the art medical clinic trade training centre.
- Since commencing operations as an RTO over 12 months ago the organisation has undertaken a full review of its management systems. Policies and procedures are reflective of day to day operations and are a consequence of the organisations approach to quality training and assessment. The organisation has a strong continuous improvement culture and a robust management system. Work is being undertaken to transition its RTO operations to a single information technology system.
- In June 2013 the RTO appointed a full time training and compliance officer. The addition of this role to the organisation has resulted in focused and streamlined approach to the RTO's operations.
- A change to the delivery from classroom based to block training has resulted in increased student retention and completion numbers. Feedback from clients and industry also supports the success of the block delivery.
- The RTO is working with local practitioners and organisations such as Medicare Local. Most recently the organisation provided input to the training package developers regarding clinical practice hours.
- Some of the outcomes from the Certificate II in Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander Primary Health Care include program -
 - St Teresa's Catholic College, Abergowrie (remote North Queensland) 19 from 22 completed the full certificate, one student accepted into Dip Nursing
 - Shalom Christian College (Regional North Queensland) 21 from 23 completed the full certificate – highest number of graduates for a Senior VET program at the school to date, 4 students accepted into Dip Nursing
 - Mount St Bernard College (Remote Far North Queensland) 8 out of 8 completed the full certificate, five students accepted into Dip Nursing
 - Students who have completed with the RTO are being sourced to fill approximately a dozen identified traineeship position at the Townsville Hospital.

 - (b) (Option 2) the NVR registered training organisation holds current membership of an approved Tuition Assurance Scheme;
 - (c) (Option 3) the NVR registered training organisation may accept payment of no more than \$1000 from each individual student prior to the commencement of the course. Following course commencement, the NVR registered training organisation may require payment of additional fees in advance from the student but only such that at any given time, the total amount required to be paid which is attributable to tuition or other services yet to be delivered to the student does not exceed \$1,500;
 - (d) (Option 4) the NVR registered training organisation holds an unconditional financial

guarantee from a bank operating in Australia for no less than the full amount of funds held by the NVR registered training organisation which are prepayments from students (or future students) for tuition to be provided by the NVR registered training organisation to those students; or

(e) (Option 5) the NVR registered training organisation has alternative fee protection measures of equal rigour approved by the National VET Regulator.
